Art Walks

- First Friday Art Walks are taking place throughout Portland's Central Eastside
- Thank you to Director Carmen Garnica, Membership Director Arty Wall, and Engagement Coordinator Kate Chase for their work on the Dia De Los Muertos themed Art Walk on Friday, 11/1
 - The event included food, music and art produced by members of the Latinx community.
- The next KBOO Art Walk will be on Friday 12/6 from 5pm until 8:30pm
 - KBOO is creating an "Art Walk" radio show to cover the events
 - Live music
 - Interviews with participants

Grants

- Thomas announced, at the October board meeting, that Collective Roots has nominated KBOO for a grant (approximately \$10,000)
 - Collective Roots is a philanthropic group of business women that supports an alternative peer group for youth.
 - A presentation about KBOO's impact and needs was given to Collective Roots by the person that nominated KBOO
 - Focused on the Youth Collective
 - Nathan provided promotional materials
 - KBOO is one of 3 nominees
 - Collective Roots will contact Nathan if KBOO is selected for the grant
- Marie Lamfrom grant
 - Letter of intent was submitted on 11/1
 - \$20K to \$50K per year for 3 years
- Jamie provided Nathan with access to the Foundation Directory and will provide tips and tools for narrowing down the list to grantors who will be interested in providing funding for KBOO Community Radio.
 - If committee and board members have existing relationships with foundations, let's focus on those first



• KBOO may have a better chance of obtaining funding with a personal relationship already established.

Planned giving

- KBOO held a planned giving seminar in 2024.
 - A KBOO member, an estate planning attorney gave a presentation on estates and planned giving.
 - The seminar was not well promoted.
 - It was not well attended.
- James will hold another (series of) planned giving event(s).
 - Direct outreach to loyal donors
 - Paper invitations via USPS to specific donors with followup by email and phone
 - Planning to schedule educational forums in August or October 2025
 - Provide mission driven reasons to create a will
 - Donors may think about KBOO when they create it
 - KBOO can think about "recognition" activities or a program for donors who plan to leave part of their estate to KBOO when they pass

October meeting followup

- At the October meeting, Ethan suggested a fundraising idea: personal sponsorships
 - Personal sponsorships
 - Ethan knows of another community radio station (Huntsville, AL) that uses this fundraising activity successfully
 - Listeners can buy air time to broadcast a message
 - "Congratulations!"
 - "Happy birthday"
 - If KBOO charges \$200 for 2 spots on the same day
 - 1 person's message per day for 365 days = \$73K
 - 2 people's messages per day for 365 days = \$146K
 - Sekoynia suggested KBOO pilot this program in February leading up to Valentine's Day.
 - Nathan is working on how underwriting will support this event for February.
 - Planning will begin once the End of Year Campaign is underway.
